DDC Grant Awards FY 23

- The DC DDC Request for Application (RFA) FY 2023 Grant Awards received 13
 applications on November 8, 2022.
- 2. The DDC Grant Review Panel discussed the results and deliberated the final decision for each application, according to the priorities of the State Plan 2022-2026.
- 3. The Grant Review Panel and Executive Committee approved five (5) applications as submitted, two (2) applications with adjustments to the budget and denied six (6) applications.
- 4. The total amount of grant awards approved is \$82,548.53.
