Future planning is a crucial step in ensuring that people with **developmental disabilities (DD)** can lead fulfilling and independent lives, particularly when a parent or caregiver is no longer able to provide support.

A person-centered future plan includes:

- Information about all aspects of a person's life, including services and supports, housing, finances, decision making, daily activities, social connections; and
- Reflects the wishes of the person with DD, as well as parents, siblings, extended family members, and friends.
